Full-time with some evening and weekend duties; \$1025 p/m living stipend; educational award upon successful completion of service.

With a mission of providing and promoting constructive and collaborative approaches to conflict through mediation, training, facilitation and community education, the WDRC is seeking an enthusiastic and creative applicant with group facilitation skills, familiarity with conflict resolution, experience working with youth and a desire to 1) work in tandem with our youth program coordinator and volunteers to provide students in our juvenile justice system and public schools with specialized training in conflict resolution, anger management, and communication skills; 2) provide support to the WDRC's outreach, training, and mediation programs to help further advance awareness of and access to our services, including our parent-teen mediation services.
